Are you still singing "Christ the Lord is risen todaaaaay, haaaaallleeeeeeelluuuuujjjaaaah!" like me? Nope, just me singing it that wildly?

I hope something from our Easter worship is still playing in your head! As we wrap up this Lenten and Easter season, I want to thank those of you who have been reading along with me every week as we have dug into Lent specific hymns that we may never have heard before.

I am not done just yet sharing these new songs with you all. So today, I would like to share with you all Hymn #311 "Now the Green Blade Riseth."

> Now the green blade riseth, from the buried grain, wheat that in the dark earth many days has lain; Love lives again, that with the dead has been: Love is come again, like wheat that springeth green.

> In the grave they laid him, Love who had been slain, thinking that he never would awake again, laid in the earth like grain that sleeps unseen: Love is come again, like wheat that springeth green.

> Forth he came at Easter, like the risen grain, Jesus who for three days in the grave had lain; quick from the dead my risen Lord is seen: Love is come again, like wheat that springeth green.

> When our hearts are wintry, grieving, or in pain, Jesus' touch can call us back to life again, fields of our hearts that dead and bare have been: Love is come again, like wheat that springest green.

As we move on from our Lenten season and our glorious Easter morning, I pray the hope we have been reminded of during this season allows our hearts to spring forth like a new, green blade that knows the Son has risen just for them.

Next week, I will share one final hymn that may or may not be new to you. It will remind us that even though Easter is now behind us for the year, we are still called to be Easter people every day of the year!


"The Chosen", beginning April 19, 9:30am
